- a. The snake would be a reminder to man of the results of the curse (angelic being).**
- b. There will never be a day of satisfaction and fulfillment.**
- c. Was This The day God created the lake of fire.**
- d. What is this that thou hast done- you were to cause him to posses destiny not abort it.**

¹⁵ *and enmity I put between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; he doth bruise thee -- the head, and thou dost bruise him -- the heel.'*

- a. The adversary has a seed.**
- b. Out from the woman shall come the avenger - the second Adam.**
- c. Satan will always have the ability to hinder but not totally prevail.**

¹⁶ *Unto the woman He said, `Multiplying I multiply thy sorrow and thy conception, in sorrow dost thou bear children, and toward thy husband [is] thy desire, and he doth rule over thee.'*

- a. He did not curse her as he did the serpent or she would have no hope of reconciliation.**
- b. Labor is to remind you that you forgot God and failed to be the counterpart for destiny.**
- c. Since you would not willfully you will not be content and at peace till you fulfill the original purpose.(alcoholic)**

**d. Rule was the result of disobedience - what was it before?
Right hand left hand.**

¹⁷ And to the man He said, `Because thou hast hearkened to the voice of thy wife, and dost eat of the tree concerning which I have charged thee, saying, Thou dost not eat of it, cursed [is] the ground on thine account; in sorrow thou dost eat of it all days of thy life,

- a. He knew Gods voice and demoted God to hear Eve.**
- b. He must have died a thousand deaths when God said cursed.**
- c. The Ground and anything that comes out of the ground or eats from the ground. (tithe)**
- d. Sorrow, Proverbs 10:22.**

¹⁸ and thorn and bramble it doth bring forth to thee, and thou hast eaten the herb of the field;

- a. The Thorn is a token of the curse Jesus crown of thorns
The blood broke the curse.**

¹⁹ by the sweat of thy face thou dost eat bread till thy return unto the ground, for out of it hast thou been taken, for dust thou [art], and unto dust thou turnest back.

²⁰ And the man calleth his wife's name Eve: for she hath been mother of all living.

- a. What was her name before the fall?**

²¹ And Jehovah God doth make to the man and to his wife coats of skin, and doth clothe them.

The self made covering was inadequate and inappropriate.

²² *And Jehovah God saith, `Lo, the man was as one of Us, as to the knowledge of good and evil; and now, lest he send forth his hand, and have taken also of the tree of life, and eaten, and lived to the age,' --*

²³ *Jehovah God sendeth him forth from the Garden of Eden to serve the ground from which he hath been take.*
