- Declaring the Word brings it manifestation speak what God Says
- ⁴ To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.
 - Titus a faithful son of the faith

⁵ For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee:

- I could go away knowing you will take care of it
- There were areas that needed shoring up and he knew he would address them
- Appoint people who would hold things up to the standard
- Titus recruited him- recruitment necessary

⁶ If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.

- There is not a reason for scandal -- bro tonic
- One Wife One Husband at a time no polygamy
- Having Faithful Children (encourage)
- Riotous living and unable to take direction not a candidate

⁷ For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not self-willed, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;

- Manages what God gave him
- stubborn, refusing to let go of jaded opinions
- anger invokes evil righteous indignation service
- Wine controls motives and habits
- quick to come to blows
- Won't pursue unless they get money out of it.

Sees the ⁸ But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; importance of making people feel welcome and received,

 Isn't in competition with others but celebrates their success not drunk with the world and worldly thoughts- carnal mind, fair in their decisions not partial nor play favorites self-control

⁹ Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

 Remembering the sound doctrine and teachings of the faith and willing to teach and stand up for them

² That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

You have the same qualifications but not the same responsibility

³ The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

- behavior that people would determine to be Godly
- The tendency to gossip and falsely accuse someone of the faith

⁴ That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

- Sober living conscious to acknowledge God in their endeavors
- teach the younger women how to love their husbands Jesus said obey (service with him- joint heirs of the promises of God)

⁵ To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

- not boisterous always yelling
- mindful of being a women of God
- your house is clean, laundry done, closets cleaned, shelves in order

 people see you respect the will of your husband as he follows Christ or kills the witness of Christ in the individuals life.

⁶ Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

Recreation should not take you out of being sober.

⁷ In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine showing uncorrupt ness, gravity, sincerity,

- Pattern tells who you are association modifies behavior those you associate with you become like.
- Sound doctrine that Elders commend
- when what you believe does not line up with the word of God corrupt
- Be sincere about your walk with the King!
