

# Assignments in the move of Restoration

## PART 2

***13 And it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I save you, and ye shall be a blessing: fear not, but let your hands be strong.***

- 4 You shall be a blessing instead of a curse.
- 5 The heaven shall give their "dew" The presence of God is experience in a deeper way.
- 6 People come to know the Lord.

***16 These are the things that ye shall do; Speak ye every man the truth to his neighbor; execute the judgment of truth and peace in your gates 17 And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbor; and love no false oath: for all these are things that I hate, saith the LORD.***

- 1 Start speaking the truth.
- 2 Stop responding to the world like the world.
- 3 Cast down that vane imagination.
- 4 Do not claim loyalty to offices or positions or groups that are false.

***18 And the word of the LORD of hosts came unto me, saying,***

- (the most difficult thing to do is to have to hear from God then wait- this is the fifth time he has come to Zechariah- it is for our good)

***19 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the truth and peace.***

- (all these fast were sack cloth and ashes due to tragic experiences encumbered by Israel) Now make them for joy, happiness and gladness

***20 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; It shall yet come to pass, that there shall come people, and the inhabitants of many cities: 21 And the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to pray before the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts: I***

***will go also.22 Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD.***

- **It Shall Yet come to pass**: Implies God people were difficult to position where he promised that he would bless them. The blessing God gives you causes others to seek God Also.

***23 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard that God is with you.***

- In Those days that closely follow the first move of positioning the "truth that you speak and the manifested blessing God procures upon you exponentially effects the lives that you come in contact with who in turn testify to others of the evidence of Jehovah in your life.
