

Assignments in the move of Restoration

Zechariah 8 / Haggai / Zechariah / Ezra / Nehemiah

8 Again the word of the LORD of hosts came to me, saying,

- The word of the Lord repeatedly had to be delivered to and by the prophets God had raised up in this time. To prepare for a "Restoration" revival that would transform the region."
- Thus saith the LORD of hosts; I was jealous for Zion with great jealousy, and I was jealous for her with great fury. **Why did God speak the word jealousy? His people were with someone else other than him!**

3 Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain. " I am returned, I am back home, You are betrothed to me.

4 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; There shall yet old men and old women dwell in the streets of Jerusalem, and every man with his staff in his hand for very age. And the streets of the city shall be full of boys and girls playing in the streets thereof.

- The staff represents the wisdom and experience of the aged- Results in the mentoring of the young and thus harmony between the generations, 1st Timothy 5 Rebuke not an Elder but entreat him as a Father and the younger men as brethren, the Elder women as mothers the younger as sisters with all purity.

6 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; If it be marvelous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, should it also be marvelous in mine eyes? saith the LORD of hosts.

- "The plan of God is to perform a work that you say as the psalmist" this is the Lords doing and it is marvelous in our eyes."

7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Behold, I will save my people from the east country, and from the west country;8 And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God, in truth and in righteousness.

- I will, the work he performs will not only be of the Temple and The Walls but the hearts of his people who belong to him who are serving other Gods

9 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Let your hands be strong, ye that hear in these days these words by the mouth of the prophets, which were in the day that the foundation of the house of the LORD of hosts was laid, that the temple might be built.

- 1st John 2:14 I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.

10 For before these days there was no hire for man, nor any hire for beast; neither was there any peace to him that went out or came in because of the affliction: for I set all men every one against his neighbour.

11 But now I will not be unto the residue of this people as in the former days, saith the LORD of hosts.

12 For the seed shall be prosperous; the vine shall give her fruit, and the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew; and I will cause the remnant of this people to possess all these things.

- "The seed shall be prosperous" The word you sow into your situations shall be prosperous - you must speak a word from God (the promises found in his word) to every area of your life. Isaiah 55-11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing where to I sent it.

II Corinthians 9:10 Now may He that ministered seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness,
