

It's A Done Deal with God!

And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience

- Quickened - made Alive Hebrews 4:11 Dead to God therefore you could not please God.
- Walked in the Flesh- (Carnal mind) the course of this world- perceive the things of the spirit
- Worketh - Not possesses (possession is either willful or due to vulnerable - children

3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

- Conversation- citizenship - uncomfortable where you don't belong. By nature-The Adamic nature (children and toys) On The course of destruction thus invoking the wrath of God -- As Everybody Else

4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

- But-connecting of the two sentences interjecting a contrasting view God's Mercy, Undeserved Exponential Love- While we were alienated

5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

- When I was practicing dead works- (312 thousand dollars for stilettos)
- Quickened us - made us alive- For whom he did foreknow he did also predestined

6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: Made us sit together (we did not cooperate) In Christ

- When He was resurrected I was resurrected in the mind of God therefore it was 'all ready done"

7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus

- I was saved so people could see I did not deserve nor could I earn his kindness and his grace and how much Jesus was a precious gift to us.
- Hebrews chapter 1 - 1-5

8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

- I gave you faith so you could accept my Son as your saviour.

9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

- That means Baptism thou commanded cannot save you, dietary laws though strongly suggested cannot save you, ect

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

- There is all ready a work in you, God has ordained it- Jeremiah- [19](#)And the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah, saying, [20](#)Thus saith the LORD; If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; [21](#)Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers.

13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

21 In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:

22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.
