⁸ They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at thy tokens: thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice.

- Your testimony has greater range than ever before due to the "Tokens for good" God manifest in your life. Outgoings is your daily budget of responsibilities and daily living- Your budget makes you to rejoice!

⁹ Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.

- The season of visitation: A word out of **season** may mar a whole lifetime. Greek **Proverb. Proverbs 26:1** *"As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honor is not seemly for a fool."*
- The chance of having snow in summer in the lower elevations just doesn't exist, and that is just as sure as your receiving or giving honor to a fool, it just doesn't happen. It is just not normal, just as it doesn't rain at harvest time. "Fool" as used in the Hebrew text in this case is a "careless or senseless man". A man that just does not use any common sense. He doesn't know when harvest season is, nor does he care.

- Thou waterest it (God knows what water does for the seed) Galatians 6:9 - Ye shall reap if you faint not' Psalm 126:6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing **precious seed**, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves *with him*.
- **Thou preparest him corn:** you get seed and substance Remember: its the season of Jubilee and the 11th hour - you get paid as much as someone who started well before you

¹⁰ Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.

- Notice: nothing wrong with the seed but the Angels begin to do wonders where you have sown. (Precious seed)

¹¹ Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness.

- Notice God references a 365 day period where he does a work that is distinct and clearly designates who is the source. 'Thou crownest"- only one person wears the crown.

¹² They drop upon the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side.

- The rain falls on things you though would be much harvest, where you received little but there is a

bumper crop on the way because of the goodness of the Lord in the land of the Living.

¹³ The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing.

- The hardships and experiences you have been going through have been to teach you how to manage the Harvest. There are flocks ready their is corn in the valley but it won't do you any good if its not in the barn.
- There is joy in you when you harvest the soul that God brings into your life for you to glean.! Psalm 126-
