⁵ I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

- A New Testament exhortation- God saved a people that never got saved themselves.
- Those people did not cross over they were destroyed.

⁶ And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

- People always say how they were thrown out Jude reminds us left their habitation - "how long before rebellion?"

⁷ Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

- The healing for homosexuality, sexual addictions, is to resist saying I am born that way. ' Giving themselves over - then going after" resist the devil and he will flee from you- don't give yourself over"

⁸ Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

- Going after -pornographic material, movies, conversation- " find a wife - act like a husband- pornography creates unrealistic expectations and emotions.-- ruins your sex life-- run, run, run.

⁹ Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

- Michael choose not to speak evil against the epitome of evil Satan because he would be risking saying evil without the lord's authority.

¹⁰ But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

- Is the enormity of this comparison is mind blowing Michael knew it was Satan He threw him out. We say things out of anger, jealousy, envy, bitterness it must create so much havoc in our lives- the fruits of a mans lips - Words Justify the Blessing.

¹¹ Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

- The greatest warning God gives woe
- Cain despised and envied his brother.
- Cursed his brothers and sisters for reward (money?)
- The ground where your seed is sown to bring forth fruit winds up swallowing you up because of idle words.

¹² These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; ¹³ Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

- 12 terrible descriptions so we would not take speaking evil lightly.

¹⁴ And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

- Enoch mentioned at the time of the Lords return and says he is going to bring judgment? (when)

¹⁶ These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling

words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

- more warnings by giving horrid descriptions of how God sees you

¹⁷ But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;¹⁸ How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.¹⁹ These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

- The spirit of Anti-Christ has them focused on sensual not the Spirit-- separated - forsake not the assembling of yourselves as you see the day approaching. The Church must seek the Holy Spirit

²⁰ But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

- dedicated to prayer in the spirit.

²¹ Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

- "Having left, went after" You can keep yourself in the love of God it is your choice.

²² And of some have compassion, making a difference: ²³: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

- love them out
- scare them out of the fire- When God sees them they are in the fire-- know it's the fleshly nature and thinking that has them captive.

²⁴ Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, ²⁵ To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.
