

## He's Now Making Room

**18 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;**

- Mankind should develop a mind that recognizes God's continual abode. "He lives with you" and have an ongoing conversation about everything.

**<sup>2</sup>Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:**

- A judge that fears not God, then cannot judge without bias. A judge that though subject to God chooses to circumvent Gods intent. God has total regard for man but the judge has no regard for man. "Roe vs Wade"

**<sup>3</sup>And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary.**

- Avenge: Vindicate, Retaliate, Punish what has chosen to come up against me.

**<sup>4</sup>And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, though I fear not God, nor regard man;**

- He would not because he is unjust her approach was based on the law that supersedes every law in the universe.
- Afterwards he recognized that the women's insistence was based upon she recognized that the law she was appealing to was greater than the unjust judge. Parable of the car. Show room: testimony -suppose to work-it new.

**<sup>5</sup>Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.**

- This women insistence on the word of the law will "weary" disable me and bring me under compliance"

**<sup>6</sup>And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.**

- Understand the continual stand though time passes between the victories or compliance is assured due to her stand on the law of God, What if she gave up in-between?

**<sup>7</sup> And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?**

- Shall not God make sure his word shall not return void though there is time that may past between. “Hope deferred makes the heart sick but when it comes it is as a tree of life!”

2 Kings 8 King James Version (KJV)

**8 Then spake Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: for the LORD hath called for a famine; and it shall also come upon the land seven years.**

- This plague is not because of you but will effect you and you will have a season of just getting buy and the appearance of having lost some things

**<sup>2</sup> And the woman arose, and did after the saying of the man of God: and she went with her household, and sojourned in the land of the Philistines seven years.**

- Philistines the land of the enemy where the laws of God were not revered and seemingly of no affect.

**<sup>3</sup> And it came to pass at the seven years end that the woman returned out of the land of the Philistines: and she went forth to cry unto the king for her house and for her land.**

- Season shifted and now she is able to invoke the covenant blessing and expect the return of that what was lost.
- She goes to the “judge” and she cry’s based on the word of the Lord and the prophets.

**<sup>4</sup> And the king talked with Gehazi the servant of the man of God, saying, Tell me, I pray thee, all the great things that Elisha hath done.**

- In this season God has already gone before you and set up your meetings, your favor is ahead of you all ready.

- God has orchestrated the return of everything that is yours to make room for what is to come exceedingly abundantly above you would ask or think!

**<sup>5</sup> And it came to pass, as he was telling the king how he had restored a dead body to life, that, behold, the woman, whose son he had restored to life, cried to the king for her house and for her land. And Gehazi said, My lord, O king, this is the woman, and this is her son, whom Elisha restored to life.**

- God has already sent somebody to talk concerning your blessing, your overflow, your harvest, your increase!

**<sup>6</sup> And when the king asked the woman, she told him. So the king appointed unto her a certain officer, saying, Restore all that was hers, and all the fruits of the field since the day that she left the land, even until now.**

- There has been an Angel assigned to you, that cannot return until he recovers everything that God has declared is yours, once again to make room for the season of Ephesians 3:20.
