Psalm 27:13-14 King James Version (KJV)

**13 I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness** of the Lord in the land of the living.

**14 Wait on the Lord:** be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord.

Read the 27 Psalm in light of his final statement

**27 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?**

- Gods aluminates his life and his quest to be is in His Salvation
- No man, no demon, no natural thing determines Destiny.
- Life emerges from his goodness.

**2 When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. 3 Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.**

- He had confidence because he was convinced that God was his source and his help.

**4 One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in his temple.**

- That's how I maintain my faith and trust in Gods promises and keep pressing into where I need to Go.

**5 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.**

- I am hidden but from hiding he will set me up on a sure foundation and I shall not be moved.
- Pavilion was like a tent he will cover me like the tabernacle of Moses.

**6 And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the Lord.**

- I am set on high, rescued (40) but he does not leave the tabernacle where he has been hiding, he gives praises and recognizes where his help comes from.

**7 Hear, O Lord, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me. 8 When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, Lord, will I seek. 9 Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation. 10 When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take me up.**

- While waiting God will give you waves of his presence with comes from his " Blessed Assurance" you're coming out of this. Then you often afterwards flow back into your reality, yet you seek God for his manifestation.

**11 Teach me thy way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.**

- Here it appears he is conscious of the fact that whatever he is dealing with won't be swept away but he can be guided around the pitfalls.

**12 Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.**

- When David was once asked which punishments would accept he said," Never let me be put into the hands of Man but he threw himself into the hand of God which he deemed to be merciful.
