

I SAW Him FALL

And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you:

- The disciples answered the call to go and to acknowledge the door of acceptance and fellowship over a meal with them according to their custom.

⁹ And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, the kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

- Clearly the infirmed were a priority with Father and the ability to heal the sick was given to them collectively.

¹⁰ But into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you not, go your ways out into the streets of the same, and say,

- Instruction to avoid those who reject the message upon hearing the message.
- The disciples were in the streets sharing the gospel with the city.

¹¹ Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

- The disciples had total confidence that their mission was viable and divine and that there would be serious consequences for rejecting their words of Life.

¹² But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for Sodom, than for that city.

- Obviously there are degrees of judgement that are inflicted upon eternal bodies with diverse impact or intensity. It is clear here that Jesus was saying that Sodom would be judged even after have been in the natural burnt up in the days of lot.

¹³ Woe unto thee, Chorazin! Woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

- Once again justice can only be seen through the eyes and ways of God. In the natural thinking of man with limited scope of the individuals and times and seasons this judgement seems to be unjust.

¹⁴ But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment, than for you.¹⁵ And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.

- Once again is the mention of an eternal place of judgement of no escape and no hope of pardon. If there is

no such place (beetles) what is Jesus talking about in such a definitive way!

¹⁶ He that heareth you heareth me; and he that despiseth you despiseth me; and he that despiseth me despiseth him that sent me.

- The Lord was so impressed and pleased with their commitment to go he saw them on the highest level of an ambassadors totally representors of HE and the kingdom.

¹⁷ And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

- This phenomena was not experienced till they accepted their mission to go. What of before? No Authority prior.

¹⁸ And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

- Revelation 12:7 Isaiah 14:12 Ezekiel 28 13-15

¹⁹ Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

- I give you power and authority – serpents demonic strongholds scorpions- vexations induced by the enemy-tormenting spirits

Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

- More important that your name is written in the book next phase is to walk in the power and authority of the Gospel to achieve solidify more names.

²¹ In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

- ABC, CBS, CNN, Academia, Elected Official, FBI, CIA, NSA, Whitehouse can all miss the most important truth in the universe and children can catch it and run.

²² All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him.

- You may never understand on this side how significant and meaningful to God you are. He doesn't reveal himself to everyone. You may walk by someone today whom the Lord doesn't bother with but choose you. How awful it is for those whom hear and reject his love and call to fellowship.
