- Sent a message (a lie) You don't have a life The scripture says "he "imagined" exactly what the lie said. "he saw that"
- What he saw influenced his decisions so much he requested God to be in agreement with him. He didn't have a future so there is no reason to walk in life. "it is enough " I don't measure up to the expectations of the Patriarchs no reason to go any further.
- "Darrel Strawberry" His Father always said I wasn't good enough"
- Depression "he slept" exhaustion and anxiety increase when you believe the lie. Food was given (proper diet of both physical and natural and the

natural was given first) In the state you are in the "journey is too great" Alpha and Omega - Prioritize

- Then the Word of the Lord Came to him- God would not speak to him till after he rested and ate. What are you doing here!
- Either you repent and go to where God had instructed "Jezreel" or you make excuses
- He had with earnest desired to keep covenant with God- everybody else around you is giving up and going along to get along- abandoned the place of prayer power- they have forged a lie against the word of truth of the prophets- and I feel so alone in this work there is nobody to help me in my mission for you and they want me to stop carrying this message.
- These were all the places of natural expectation of mankind for God to show up and give direction but with his own his desire is intimate and he reveals that in a still small voice.
