Psalms 140:1 -13

Psalms 140:1 Deliver me, O Lord, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

Romans 7:24 Oh wretched man that I am, who shall deliver me from the body of this death. **Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongues

Psalms 140:2 -Which imagine mischief's in their heart; continually are they gathered together for war. **James 4:1** - From whence come wars and fighting's among you? Come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members.

Psalms140:3 - They have sharpened their tongues like a serpent; adders' poison is under their lips. Selah. **James 3:8** But the tongues can no man tame, it is unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

Psalms140:4 - Keep me, O Lord, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings. **Proverbs 6:2** You have been ensnared by the word of your mouth. **Galatians 5:17** The flesh wars against the spirit and the spirit the flesh and these are contrary to one another so that you cannot do the things that you would.

Psalms 140:5 - The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. **Mathew 12:36** But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. **Mathew 12:37** The words you say now reflect your fate then; either you will be justified by them or you will be condemned. "*You don't set a trap in a mans past you lay it for its future*"

Psalms 140:6 - I said unto the Lord, Thou art my God: hear the voice of my supplications, O Lord.

Psalms 66: 18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me: "...the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth." **Genesis 8:21.** "And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every.

Psalms 140:7 - O God the Lord, the strength of my salvation, thou hast covered my head in the day of battle. "*The Battle is in the Mind For the control of the tongue*" 3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh:

(For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Psalms 140:8 Grant not, O Lord, the desires of the **wicked**: further not his wicked device; lest they exalt themselves. Selah. Answer :

1st Corinthians 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

11 And such were some of you: **but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

Psalms 140:9 - As for the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them.

"Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made"

Psalms 140:10 - Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits that they rise not up again. Romans 12:20

Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou **shalt heap coals of fire on his head**

Psalms 140:11 - Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow him.

Psalm 7 14&15 Behold, the wicked man conceives evil and is pregnant with mischief and gives birth to lies. 15 He makes a pit, digging it out, and falls into the hole that he has made. 16 His mischief returns upon his own head, and on his own skull his violence descends.

Psalms 140:12 - I know that the Lord will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and the right of the poor.

Psalm 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings (bad news) his heart is fixed, trusting in the lord.

Psalms 140:13 - Surely the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name: the upright shall dwell in thy presence.

Psalm 8 " Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightiest still the enemy and the avenger.
