

The Feast of Rosh Hashanah: The New Year

Rosh Hashanah: Head of the Year

1. Begins a ten day period of repentance which concludes with Yom Kippur the Day of Atonement.
2. Rosh Hashanah also means: The Opening of the Gate
3. The keys of Evaluation
 - Am I Paying My Tithes
 - Am I Sacrificing
 - Am I Kind
 - Am I Forgiving
 - Am I Gracious
 - Am I gracious

Thirty Days before priest would blow the Trumpet that Rosh Hashanah was coming; the season of the "eye of evaluation" and scrutiny of Jehovah was coming. A new beginnings was on the way. It signified by the warning of the Trumpet that God had not given up on us we could make the changes.

Note: 30 days ago we were blowing the trumpet for our conference time (10 days) in which the Theme of our conference was "Awake". The blowing of the trumpet is to stir the people to repentance and turn towards God.

The Tulmud: a collection of writings on Jewish law and custom and religious practice

According to the Talmud God opens up three books of Judgment on Rosh Hashanah

- The righteous (those who returned to God)
- The wholly wicked (all of the names of the unrighteous)
- The Third book has the name of the intermediates - those who have not yet been judged and have ten days to repent before the Day of Atonement. Then their names are added to the book of the righteous.
- Revelation 3:15-16 I know your works that ye are neither cold nor hot. So then ye are luke warm and therefore I spill ye out of My mouth.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

The word Righteous means- Salt and Light. Rosh Hashanah also is called Feast of Trumpets. The sounding of the Trumpet is to announce a New King or to summon the army to battle. AWAKE, A third is a call to worship - You need desperately all three to have the success God has planned to give you.

- I have more than enough
- I prosper and I am in good health even as my soul prosper
- I am going to live and not die and declare the works of the Lord
- I am Salt and Light and Family, Friends, Enemies, See my good works and glorify God
