

The I Will's of God

Questions and Progression

The first "I will" I want to call your attention to, occurs in Matthew 11: 28: "Come unto me all ye that labor, and I will give you rest.

"Him that cometh unto me I will in no wise cast out." John 6:37

"I will" is found in Luke, fifth chapter. We read of a leper who came to Christ, and said: "Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean." 12 verse

"Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven." There's the "I will" of confession Luke 12:38

"Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." Mathew 4:19

The next "I will" is in John, fourteenth chapter, verse eighteen: "I will not leave you comfortless." John 14:18

Then there is another I will in John, sixth chapter, verse forty; it occurs four times in the chapter: "I will raise him up at the last day." John 6:40

Now the next I will is in John, seventeenth chapter, twenty-fourth verse: "Father, I will that they also, whom Thou hast given Me, be with Me where I am." John 17:24
