

The Truth I Know

Parable of your name.

Hosea 6:3 King James Version (KJV)

3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

- Shall process: after the process has finished
- You shall know the Lord: Ye shall know the Logos “the word of God” How?
- Follow the prepared path already ordained – How sure? As the morning.
- He shall reveal himself as rain “the former and the latter” abundance – I shall increase you more and more you and your children.

Mathew 4

¹⁸ And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

¹⁹ And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

²⁰ And they straightway left their nets, and followed him.

- If you follow me: I will make you! Follow me I can work inside you and mold you and shape you’

Jeremiah 18- 5 Then the word of the Lord came to me. 6 He said, “Can I not do with you, Israel, as this potter does?” declares the Lord. “Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand, Israel.

John 8

31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

- If you continue: not a new theme, how often do we stop our pursuit or following the lord because we don't like the direction.
- We create another path then we say to the Lord "follow me"

32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

- As we follow we learn truth and it frees us from the curse that Adam wrought when he choose "not to follow" the Lords instruction. "It's the Truth You Know That Makes You Free"
