What Has God Been Saying: So You Can Say It

Matthew 18:18

Verily I say unto **you**, **Whatsoever** ye shall **bind** on earth shall be bound in heaven: and **whatsoever** ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

- The messages you hear are for you to agree, and say on earth (your authority is already given in heaven you must execute here on earth)
- Seek ye first the Kingdom- These things (the things God has for you) added unto you (along with what you have he give more) God gives you what to say so it will be released for you in heaven. What Has God Been Saying?
- Divine Surprises
- (Hid) Isaiah 49 God was making us sharp in the word- He made my mouth a sharp sword – when he hid you, he was making you and working for you!
- Reading the time for the days are evil (Ephesians 5:16) Getting back what we lost over time.
- The Harvest: James 5:7 King James Version (KJV)
7 Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.
- Say: This is my due season: **Galatians 6:9**
And let us not be weary in well doing: for in **due season** we shall reap, if we faint not. (God would be sending messages about your time has come, will come, did come)
 - Demonstrate Confidence in the seed (enthusiasm and expectation)
 - Clearly define your harvest

- Water the seed by speaking over it – decree the promise daily – songs hymns spiritual songs imperative
- Keep the weeds out! Words of doubt, fear, strife, jealousy, unforgiveness, gossip (Hate Kills The Seed)
- Continually Praise God for The Harvest
- Don't give up on your seed
- Keep sowing (God gives seed to the sower) for future harvest
