

# What Was The More In The Moreover Over

## Jeremiah 29:11

*11 For I have known the thoughts that I am thinking towards you -- an affirmation of Jehovah; thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give to you posterity and hope.*

*12 Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.*

*13 And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.*

1. There is the plan of the Father he thinks towards you. Remember all the promises of God are voice activated. You must say what he is saying and thus is the main reason for this divine dialogue.

## Jeremiah 31

*31 At the same time, saith the Lord, will I be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be my people.*

2. God tells them what he is thinking that has not manifested- Families will turn to God

*2 Thus saith the Lord, The people which were left of the sword found grace in the wilderness; even Israel, when I went to cause him to rest.*

3. I found out that I dont deserve his Blessing but Jesus earned it for me. Like Caleb I am crying GRACE to the mountain

*3 The Lord hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with loving kindness have I drawn thee.*

4. The Lord declares so we declare "Gods love is everlasting; I am drawing you to protect and prosper you.

*4 Again I will build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel: thou shalt again be adorned with thy tabrets, and shalt go forth in the dances of them that make merry.*

*5 Thou shalt yet plant vines upon the mountains of Samaria: the planters shall plant, and shall eat them as common things.*

*6 For there shall be a day, that the watchmen upon the mount Ephraim shall cry, Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion unto the Lord our God.*

- I will build thee
- I see you purged from your past
- I going to give you a song of praise

- It will move you to dance like David use too.
- Even in troublous times you will produce ministry
- The true watchmen will Arise so all the people will Arise

**7 For thus saith the Lord; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations: publish ye, praise ye, and say, O Lord, save thy people, the remnant of Israel.**

5. God says say what I am Saying Declare it.

**8 Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the coasts of the earth, and with them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and her that travaileth with child together: a great company shall return thither.**

**9 They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn.**

**10 Hear the word of the Lord, O ye nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd doth his flock.**

6. BEHOLD- I am drawing, calling, I am a Father, I am a Shepherd, GOD SAYS WHAT WE MUST DO - DECLARE IT!

**11 For the Lord hath redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of him that was stronger than he.**

7. You and God understand what you are facing you cant fix your way it must be by your dependence on the heavenly Father.

**12 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the Lord, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.**

**13 Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, both young men and old together: for I will turn their mourning into joy, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow.**

**14 And I will satiate the soul of the priests with fatness, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, saith the Lord.**

8. God emphasizes the goodness of the Lord, his prosperity, turning mourning into joy, comfort

*15 Thus saith the Lord; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not.*

*16 Thus saith the Lord; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the Lord; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy.*

*17 And there is hope in thine end, saith the Lord, that thy children shall come again to their own border.*

9. **Don't equate what happened then to your circumstance now: I will save I will Deliver, I will set free.**
