

WHY HAGGAR DIDNT HAVE FACEBOOK

9And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking. 1.... It was Sarah's suggestion due to her "desire" to meet her husbands desire. 2... The unwillingness to wait for what God had said created this problem but fully anticipated by God. 3.... Now due to the fulfillment of Gods promise, decisions you made to reach your happiness without consulting God are grave problems.

Genesis 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

1... Desire, longing or craving for emotionally "Women's problem is that they worship the men in their lives and look to them for affirmation and provision emotionally and spiritually for things that God alone is supposed to provide. Their problem is IDOLATRY."

10Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, even with Isaac.

1... She is in the way and the son is in the way of my "desire" 2... This child is a reminder of your bond and relationship with both for which she wanted exclusive rights. 3... The disdain and feelings of being deprived of "Desire" motivated Sarah to demand" separation" God Agreed!

11And the thing was very grievous in Abraham's sight because of his son.

1... It was very grievous not because of Hagar but because of his son. 2... The bond during pregnancy was undeniable, the excitement and anticipation 3... As with his son later it was clear he loved Sarah as scripture say Jacob loved Rachel but was sleeping repeatedly with Leah.

12And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah

hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

1... God knows of the difficulty of "Soul Ties" and anticipates the proper bond between Sarah, Abraham, and Isaac will not be a harmonious one and agrees that the relationship should be broke off now and to proceed no further.

2... God sees a problem with Abraham and the ability to balance and have meaningful relationship with both thus God separates and puts distance between them. To comfort him he tells him I will make sure he is covered.

¹³And also of the son of the bondwoman will I make a nation, because he is thy seed.

1.... Because Hagar slept with you it didn't change her status with you.
2.... That's how you saw her before and sex didn't change how you viewed her. (Ladies sex does not make him love or see you any different but only satisfies a physiological need he requires. 3. Sarah he viewed as his wife and partner and that's how hew saw her despite sleeping with you never changed how he saw her.

¹⁴And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave it unto Hagar, putting it on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

1.... Ladies how often is it when you sleep with boys or men you wind up wandering in the wilderness. Sometimes wandering with child. 2... What ever he is giving you please remember that's not your source. 3... He sent her away never to communicate again due to the soul ties that were created. 4.... Next god tells her where the focus should be.

¹⁷And the water was spent in the bottle, and she cast the child under one of the shrubs. 1... What ever he tries to do "it's going to run out" of meeting the need of your desire, your fulfillment.

¹⁶And she went, and sat her down over against him a good way off, as it were a bow shot: for she said, let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against him, and lift up her voice, and wept.

1... She sat herself down when things ran out. 2...she had said to herself Abraham can't help me and I can't help myself. And I can't bear to look at the problem any longer 3... She lifted up her voice. (Towards her source)

¹⁷And God heard the voice of the lad; and the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? fear not; for God hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.

1... her voice was to her source God showed her where her longing should be and where her responsibility lied, she cried but God heard the voice of the Lad.

¹⁸Arise, lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him a great nation.

1... Your desire by nature was to lift up Abraham but assign you lift up the lad, You want to cling to Abraham but hold him in thine hand, If you do that I will make him a great man of God. 2...And though you are wondering I know how to find you and direct you.

¹⁹And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink. 1... As long as she was on Face book she couldn't see what the Author of the Good Book had right beside her. 2... Abraham gave her a bottle God gave her a well, more than enough! "My God will supply your need"

²⁰And God was with the lad; and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer.

1... God was with the lad. 2... If he had stayed with Abraham he would have been a sheep or a cattle herder. Not The Plan 3.. God had a mentor to teach him another trade or profession which is his destiny. "Archer" The mentor must see their impute as important not babysitting but divinely imputing destiny.
