

YOM KIPPUR

Each fall, the Jews around the world recognize Yom Kippur, or the Day of Atonement, on the tenth day after Rosh Hashanah. On this night, sundown begins the 24 hours of the feast of Yom Kippur- an appointed time at which God has decided to meet us in a way that is different from any other time of the year.

During the meeting, God writes your name in the "Book of Blessings" for the next year so that the windows of heaven can be opened over your life, your family, your finances, and your future- windows that cannot be closed for the entire year.

For 40 days leading up to this night they have been blowing the Trumpet calling for people to wake up!

40 significance

- Noah
- Moses Fasted 40 days and nights
- 12 spies sent for 40 days
- Goliath stood and cursed Israel for 40 days before David slew him.
- Jonah preached 40 days to Nineveh.
- 40 days between Jesus ascension and resurrection.

Leviticus 16:3-4

The High Priest had to be clean. The pulpits of America must be repented and transparent and sincerely petition God for the people.

Leviticus 6-10

Two goats - one is offered and the other is let to go into the wilderness called the "Scape Goat" "One sacrifice dies so the other can live. Jesus was our sacrifice that we can live but we will see in Hebrews he fulfills all the roles of the day of Atonement. If the scapegoat who was released in the wilderness dies in the wilderness the curse and our sins are wiped away for a year. If the goat manages to return the only our sins are forgiven but the curses remain.

Leviticus 15-21

Consecrates the Holy Place with goat of the sin offering.

Arron lays his hands on a live goat confesses over it the peoples sins and breaking the curse of sin.

Hebrews 9:11-14 (KJV)

- 11** But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;
- 12** Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- 13** For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:
- 14** How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 10:17-24 (KJV)

- 17** And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- 18** Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.
- 19** Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,
- 20** By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;
- 21** And having an high priest over the house of God;
- 22** Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
- 23** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised ;)
- 24** And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:
