¹⁶ And he who did receive the five talents, having gone, wrought with them, and made other five talents; ¹⁷in like manner also he who [received] the two, he gained, also he, other two; No socialism yet the ability through investment (seed- friends- give shall be- van sow someone who needs one also.)

¹⁸ and he who did receive the one, having gone away, digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. 1... it belongs to the Lord 2... the earth represents from which we came out of - He was sowing into himself 3... no matter what their can be no value from it that eternal.

¹⁹ And after a long time cometh the lord of those servants, and taketh reckoning with them; ²⁰and he who did receive the five talents having come, brought other five talents, saying, ` Sir, five talents thou didst deliver to me; lo, other five talents did I gain besides them.²¹ And his lord said to him, Well done, servant, good and faithful, over a few things thou wast faithful, over many things I will set thee; enter into the joy of thy lord.²² And he who also did receive

the two talents having come, said, Sir, two talents thou didst deliver to me; lo, other two talents I did gain besides them.²³ His lord said to him, Well done, servant, good and faithful, over a few things thou wast faithful, over many things I will set thee; enter into the joy of thy lord. 1... you will give an account of what he gave you 2... what he gave you is designed to increase 3... Your willingness to use and invest guarantees your promotion with greater territory.

²⁴ And he also who hath received the one talent having come, said, Sir, I knew thee, that thou art a hard man, reaping where thou didst not sow, and gathering from whence thou didst not scatter;²⁵ and having been afraid, having gone away, I hid thy talent in the earth; lo, thou hast thine own! 1.. Upon reckoning he incriminates himself with a lame excuse his total concern was for himself now he appears as a good steward, if it had been about his Lord he would have invested.

²⁶ And his lord answering said to him, Evil servant, and slothful, thou hadst known that I reap where I did not sow, and I gather whence I did not scatter! ²⁷it behoved thee then to put my money to the money-lenders, and having come I had received mine own with increase. 1... If it was about me that should have compelled you to invest. 2... The Lord emphasizes it was his money. 3... you were assured of an increase.

²⁸ Take therefore from him the talent, and give to him having the ten talents, (It appears this happens after the reckoning and reward)

²⁹ for to every one having shall be given, and he shall have overabundance, and from him who is not having, even that which he hath shall be taken from him;

³⁰ and the unprofitable servant cast ye forth to the outer darkness; there shall be the weeping and the gnashing of the teeth.

1... Outer Darkness has been attributed to the final separation and judgment. 2.... Reason - they did not bring forth a profit on a sure deal.
